Workshops / The Institute holds a session to discuss the Israeli scene.

On Saturday, April 8, 2023, the Politics and Society Institute held a closed session on the situation in the occupied territories in an attempt to understand and frame the latest developments in the scene and develop a theoretical and practical framework for the Jordanian strategy that must be followed in dealing with the new changes that have occurred in the scene, with the continuous change in Israeli governments and the recent protests that accompanied the judicial reform law in Israel, and the rise of tension in the occupied territories and in Jerusalem as a result of the Jewish holiday coinciding with Ramadan. It is noteworthy that a group of Jordanian experts and academics participated in this session, and as a speaker, the former Foreign Minister Dr. Marwan Muasher presented the new strategy of Jordanian foreign policy to deal with the Palestinian issue based on the demand for equal rights for Palestinians considering the reality towards the reality of one state.
